- 2. The Lighthouse Guidance information from the SCSC should be taken home for further review
- 3. The Audit started the end of the fiscal year and should be complete sometime in August.
- 4. School promotion ceremonies: Comments provided by Col Morris and Mr. Merritt noting that everything was well organized, put together and upbeat. Well done overall!

- 5. Mr. Cason advised that safety/security training will be done at all school locations; that staff is trained every year on an ongoing basis. Building security has been reviewed with the local authorities.
- 6. A warehouse location has been secured in Fayetteville and they are in the process of moving. This will eliminate storage cost which should allow us to see some savings. There will be someone on site in charge of inventory, which will assist with better tracking.
- 7. There is another week to go in the Summer Enrichment program. A comparison will be done in September. Funds were provided by the Cares Act.
- 8. 13 members of the Leadership Team is in DC this week attending the National Charter School Conference. The Counselors will attend a retreat in Dallas, TX and the Nurses will have a retreat as well.

Mr. Cason also pointed out that an additional Vice Principal has been hired. Mr. Scott should be an excellent addition to the staff. They almost have all teacher position hired.
