- ◆- Meeting called to order 6:30PM

- ◆- Academic Update –
 - Ms. Rutledge stated that they completed GMAS; they did have to do some retesting - 19 for ELA and 22 for Math, out of 92 8th graders. They are waiting to see how they rank against the District. They have 100% pass rate. Scholars did well with the AP testing. She and Ms. Hunt attended awards day at Drew HS where we sent 15 students; 8 were in the top 10% with a 4.0GPA. The #1 student was one of ours! Special shout out to the Counselors.
 - Ms. Jackson spoke for Dr. Yusuf, stating that they also had to retest some students. They comprised a remediation plan which worked. They will do a data analysis to look at the achievement scores and growth. The scholars had a great time at the park for Field Day, enjoying the ice cream truck, dj and games.
- ◆- Sports – Mr. Lewis said Soccer season was completed; that they made it to the semi-final round. Congratulations to the team!
 - There is a baseball game on Thursday and Saturday. The championship game should be soon.
 - The sports season is over for now, but there will be an end of year interest meeting.
- ◆ Mr. Cason noted that they are about to start building upkeep for the next school year. He hopes to have some trees cut down soon and will work on more space for elementary.
