- ◆- Meeting called to order 6:32PM
- ◆- Approval of Agenda – Motion made by Mr. Mack, second by Mr. Culver; motion
 - carried unanimously
- ◆- Approval of June 2025 Minutes – Motion made by Mr. Mack, second by Mr. Culver; motion carried unanimously
- ◆- Financial Report – Mr. Cason noted that there will not be a financial report this month as July is Year End close and they are prepping for the audit.
 - Mr. Cason pulled up the DIA website, advising where everyone can go to find the Charter Contract, audit and SY25-26 Budget.
 - Mr. Cason noted that the approved QBE for SY25-26 is \$20,733,163 (approx.).
 - Title 2 & Title 4 budgets, approx. \$140k, have been placed on hold at this time. It is anticipated that they should be released soon
- ◆- Academic Update - Dr. Yusuf introduced Ms. Adina Wade, the new 2nd & 3rd grade Asst. Principal at Church St., and Ms. K. Squires, a new Instructional Coach for 2nd & 3rd grades. She also noted the 4th & 5th grade Asst. Principal, Mrs. Jackson, is out on maternity leave.
 - Ms. Brooke Rose is the new Asst. Principal at Main Street.
 - Mr. Cason played part of the New School Orientation video and said he would send it out.
 - July 24th will be a giveaway of slightly used uniforms, clothes and shoes.
 - Mrs. Howard noted that we have approximately 61 new Eagles coming in; they are setting the tone for the school year.
 - Testing update:
 - Dr. Yusuf provided a data review for the elementary level and noted that it does not include re-test scores. She also noted that they have new reading standards and are already ahead of the game. Mr. Scott reviewed the Milestone data for the middle school.
 - AVID- all are excited about AVID and how it takes us back to old school teaching standards; that all sat down as a team and created goals for the new year.
- ◆- School Operations - Mr. Cason advised that the Clayton County Health Department required us to have outdoor grease traps installed, so that has been done.
- ◆- Old Business – None noted.
